| 4. | NFL Season: | 17 Weeks, Each NFL team gets one bye. |
| 5. | Season Opener: | THU, Sept 4th, night game. NY Giants @ Was Redskins |
| 6. | NFL Byes: | All Byes will occur during weeks 3-10. Everyone plays from Week 11 onward. |
